<b>CARE AND MANAGEMENT OF GENERAL ADULT POPULATION</b>
Assessing patients with a common internal medicine presentation
Proposing a management plan for patients with a common internal medicine presentation
Caring of adults with minor episodic problem
Identifying unstable patients
Obtaining an informed consent for procedures
Respecting patients' autonomy in decision making
<b>CARE COORDINATION</b>
Communicating the discharge plans to patients from the acute care setting
Facilitating care transitions
Responding to an urgent request from a nurse or colleague
Performing handover
<b>COMMUNICATION</b>
Facilitate a patient's participation in a health care decision using informed decision-making (or using formal decision-aid)
<b>MANAGEMENT AND LEADERSHIP</b>
Managing one's own priorities in the daily work
Working within interprofessional health care teams
<b>QUALITY OF CARE</b>
Accessing to reliable data of medical literature
Accessing medical information to provide evidence-based care for adult patients
Using evidence-base guidelines and other forms of decision support in the care for acute illness, chronic disease, and healthcare maintenance needs
Documenting patient medical information and care plan via an electronic health record effectively and in a time-efficient manner
Performing comprehensive medication review and reconciliation utilizing an EHR that allows electronic prescribing
Documenting clinical encounters
Documenting and sharing patient medical information via an electronic health record
Selecting and organizing elements to be documented in the (electr.) health record
